Welcome to our Band Family! The Circleville Band Boosters is an organization that has one objective: To Support our Students!

WHO WE ARE

The Circleville Band Boosters is a non-profit 501c3 organization that supports the CHS and CMS band programs, which include Marching Band, Concert Band, Jazz Band, Percussion, and Color Guard. Every family who has a student registered in band can be a member of the Circleville Band Boosters.

BOOSTER BUDGET

The Circleville Band Boosters have more than \$35,000 in expenditures annually. Approximately 85% of all our expenses are funded by our Band Boosters, and approximately 15% funded by Circleville High School. Expenses include: transportation of instruments to and from away football games and band competitions; instrument purchase, repair, and maintenance; awards; scholarships; uniform maintenance and cleaning; and band meals. Because the cost per student to participate in band exceeds \$300 per year, various fundraisers take place to help offset these costs. We fundraise by selling concessions at home football games, selling spirit wear, Kroger Community Rewards program, Amazon Smile rewards, by operating our booth at The Pumpkin Show, our annual Food Truck Festival, and the Circleville Cavalcade of Bands OMEA Marching Band Competition. Volunteers are always welcome and your support ensures a successful and positive band experience for our students.

FEES

Attached you will find the 2020-2021 Band Fee Payment Form. The band fees cover less than a third of the cost per student to participate in our award winning band. Your student's fee helps to pay for professional drill design, music, competition registration fees, transportation, uniforms, shoes, t-shirts, shorts, and gloves, etc.

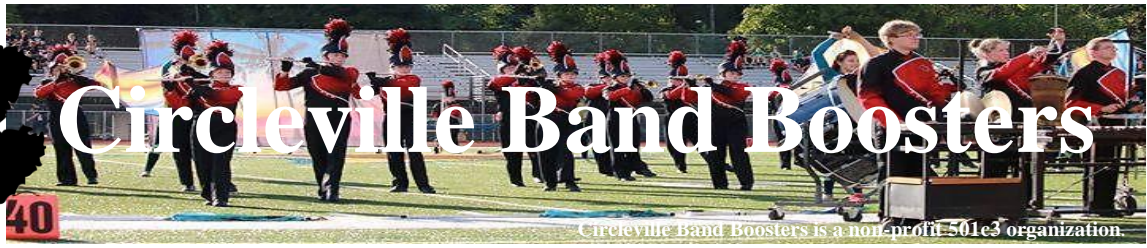

Credit card payments are processed through PayPal and offer the following options:

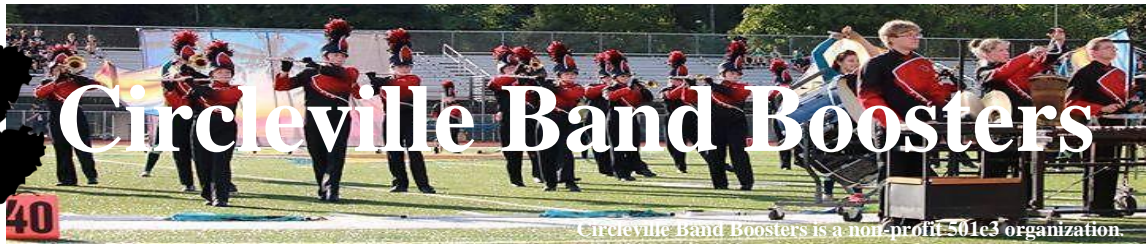
- a. You may pay the fee in full; or*

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2020-2021 MARCHING BAND UNIFORM POLICY AND INSTRUCTIONS

As it is costly to outfit the Tiger Marching Band in their beautiful performance uniforms, we must remind parents and students of the responsibility of caring for the uniforms and implement the following uniform policy and instructions:

- Summer uniforms and performance uniforms are provided to each student with the exception of black socks. Black “no show” socks and tall crew socks will be needed.
- **Summer uniforms** shall consist of red polo shirts, black shorts, black band shoes, and black “no show” socks (to be provided by the parents/student). The band director(s) will advise students and also may announce via the Remind App or social media when summer uniforms are to be worn.
- **Performance uniforms** shall consist of the “older” or the “newer” jacket, long black pants with black shorts worn underneath, red band polo shirt or solid red or black tee-shirt only (**white/brightly colored tee-shirts, tank shirts, cut-offs, baggy pants, and jeans are not permitted under the uniform**), tall black socks (“no show” socks are not permitted with the performance uniform), black band shoes, and band hat with plume. As part of the overall uniform, hair shall be kept a natural color with no unnatural hair dyes throughout the duration of the marching season, and long hair shall be pulled up and kept under the hat so it doesn’t touch the collar. Uniforms are to be hung up properly after each performance and left at the school at all times. Students will receive instruction on how to care for their uniform. **The band director makes the decision as to which band jacket shall be worn for each performance.**
- Replacement of lost or damaged items such as black gloves and parts of the summer uniform are the responsibility of the students/parents and can be obtained through the Band Director or Uniform Coordinator. Socks can be purchased on an emergency basis for \$1.00 per pair only while the uniform coordinator is distributing uniforms for an event.
- Performance uniforms including band jackets, long black pants, band hat, hat band, gloves, and plumes are the property of Circleville City Schools and therefore, school policy shall apply to the damage or loss of any portion of said uniform while in the student’s possession for any event or performance. All decisions pertaining to the replacement of any lost or damaged part of a performance uniform shall be solely at the discretion of school administration pursuant to school policy.
